- Co-founder of the #Meth-Lab methodological workshop series. In 2017, together with a colleague and close friend, I founded #Meth-Lab at our Faculty of Social Sciences. By organizing entry-level workshops on methods for PhD's and post-docs, #Meth-Lab perfectly combines my genuine interest in methods and wish for social cohesion at work.
- Co-founder of the educational game, Bonding Beyond Borders. Together with some undergraduate students, I developed a board-game and online campaign aimed at tackling stereotypes and prejudices at a young age. Our project, called Bonding Beyond Borders, won the First Prize in the Spring 2018 Facebook Global Digital Challenge (click here for more info) and is, since then, translated and broadened to target more countries and stakeholders.
